Northern Devon foodbank opened in July 2012 to give people in crisis hope, practical help, and a brighter future. We value all of our supporters who make a big difference.

Over 94,600 (mid-2016 est. - Wikipedia) people live below the poverty line in Northern Devon. We provide three days' emergency food and support to local men, women and children in crisis. Our vision is to ensure that no-one in Northern Devon has to go hungry.

Food Donations

All of our food is generously donated by people in the local community (schools, businesses, churches and individuals) and volunteers of all backgrounds help to sort, pack, and distribute food parcels to individuals and families in need. Local people are feeding local people.

Frontline Care Professionals

The families and individuals who come to us have been referred by care professionals. Social workers, health visitors, school liaison officers and others, work with us to help people in crisis so that they do not have to go hungry.
