The Christmas Fund

ESTABLISHED IN 1990 AND HAS PROVIDED SUPPORT FOR OVER 3,000 LOCAL NORTH DEVON FAMILIES

The Christmas Fund is a separate ring-fenced account to support local families in North Devon & Torridge Districts that are in longer term need beyond the short term services provided by local foodbanks. Frontline professionals refer qualifying families who are given supermarket vouchers so that they can do their Christmas shopping. Priority is given to families with children. The vouchers cannot be spent on alcohol, tobacco or lottery tickets. If funds permit, the most needy children are also provided with presents or present vouchers. The Christmas Fund was established in 1990 and has provided support for about 3000 families. It is administered by the Northern Devon Foodbank, a registered charity in England & Wales. TO ENSURE LOCAL FAMILIES HAVE A HAPPIER CHRISTMAS

Each year, the community comes together to host fundraising events for The Christmas Fund. The funds are then exchanged for shopping vouchers to purchase their Christmas food shop and presented to local families throughout December. With lack of events happening this year due to COVID 19, we value fundraising events more than ever and through the help of the local community, we hope to help as many local families as possible this Christmas.



Timeline of Fundraising for The Christmas Fund 2020

JULY

We're currently sitting at £3,300 monies in The Christmas Fund pot, we hope to £10,000 amount of funds by December in order to keep up with the previous year's demand.

SEPTEMBER

By September we hope to have raised £6,500 amount of funds on the back of the local community hosting virtual fundraising events and kind donations.

NOVEMBER

November is a crucial time for The Christmas Fund as we give a final push to receive as much funds as possible and plan the amount we will be able to distribute to local families.

DECEMBER

The Christmas Fund monies
will be exchanged for
vouchers and distributed to
local families early
December. This gives
families enough time to
purchase their Christmas
food shop before the big day.
